DHYG3330: Pediatrics, Adolescents, and Oral Health

Credit Hours: 3 Clock Hours: 45/0/0

This course addresses the prevalence, etiology, and consequences of early childhood caries (ECC). Students will learn to assess health risk factors, recognize the various stages of ECC, and counsel patients and their guardians on preventative techniques and services. Additionally, this course will discuss common oral developmental issues from infancy through adolescence.
